

Step Up brings together Minneapolis young people with Twin Cities employers through internships and training that build careers and lead to a diverse, skilled, and equitable workforce.

To be eligible you must:

- · Have a home address in the city of Minneapolis
- •Be 14-21 years old by June 1, 2022
- Not be currently enrolled in college (PSEO is okay)
- •Be eligible to work in the U.S. by June 1, 2022

AND one of the following must also apply:

- Meet family income guidelines
- Be a student with a disability
- · Have an IEP or 504 plan
- •Be an English Language Learner
- Be pregnant or parenting
- ·Be experiencing homelessness or high mobility
- •Be involved in the foster care system
- · Have been involved in the justice system

Complete Work Readiness Training

You MUST complete training to be eligible for a paid Step Up experience.

All trainings will be online. You must complete training within your

You must complete training within your assigned two-week timeframe but can work at your own pace.

After completion, eligible students can earn elective high school academic credit.

Pursue an internship by completing the hiring process OR prepare to be part of the online Career Exploration Program.



Launch Your Experience!

Step Up internships begin June 21 and end August 19.

The Step Up online Career Exploration Program begins July 11.

Step Up has two unique opportunities in 2022 to help young people kick-start their careers:

Paid Internships

After completion of training, participants who are matched with an internship will complete additional preparation steps.

- Level 1 interns (14-15 years old) will earn \$12.75/hour
- Level 2 interns (16-21 years old) will earn at least \$15/hour.

Paid Career Exploration Program

All participants: After completion of training, participants who do not work in an internship can participate in the online Career Exploration Program. In this fiveweek paid experience, participants can earn up to \$600. Eligible students can also earn elective high school academic credit. Can't make your assigned Work Readiness Training dates? Contact us BEFORE your training if you need to reschedule in order to remain an active participant.

Step Up is proud to offer paid career experiences for all youth who successfully complete Work Readiness Training. While internships are not guaranteed – and fewer are available as our community continues to recover from the COVID-19 pandemic – all youth who complete training and are not matched to an internship will be invited to participate in our five-week paid online Career Exploration Program.
